Seeds of Change

8 Week Group Program for Recovery from Eating Disorders

 Development of functional living skills in nutrition, meal preparation and eating in the community setting. Independence in managing meals

Support Physical Wellness with medical monitoring and regular patterns of eating, with reductions in eating disorder behaviours

Psycho-education and self-reflection topics to develop insight into eating disorder/s [causes, triggers, maintaining factors] and personal recovery

- Social Connectedness with peer support and peer role modelling
- Skill development in emotion regulation, mindfulness and self-compassion
- To develop meaning and purpose in life, in line with personal values
- To grow beyond the eating disorder and develop a strong sense of self-identity
- Open to both males and females aged 18+ years
- Any eating disorder diagnosis
- Medically and emotionally stable
- BMI > 16

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- Under the care of a medical doctor and an allied health practitioner
- Willing to commit to an eight week program
- Suitable for early intervention; step-up; step-down and step-in [relapse-prevention or re-occurrence]
- Ix Weekly [4 hrs] group based program [8-12 participants]
- Strengths based, recovery model and individual goal setting and support
- Co-delivered by allied health practitioner with expertise in eating disorders and a peer worker with a lived experience of an eating disorder
- Shared Care model with referral pathways for 1:1 care with individual medical and allied health practitioners. Shared care arrangements with GP for medical monitoring
- Carer support and education available
- Financially accessible


