Genesis 17:1-7; 15-16

1. When Abram was ninety-nine years old, the Lord appeared to Abram, and said to him, "I am God Almighty; walk before me, and be blameless. 2 And I will make my covenant between me and you, and will make you exceedingly numerous." 3 Then Abram fell on his face; and God said to him, 4 "As for me, this is my covenant with you: You shall be the ancestor of a multitude of nations. 5 No longer shall your name be Abram, but your name shall be Abraham; for I have made you the ancestor of a multitude of nations. 6 I will make you exceedingly fruitful; and I will make nations of you, and kings shall come from you. 7 I will establish my covenant between me and you, and your offspring after you throughout their generations, for an everlasting covenant, to be God to you and to your offspring after you. 15 God said to Abraham, "As for Sarai your wife, you shall not call her Sarai, but Sarah shall be her name. 16 I will bless her, and moreover I will give you a son by her. I will bless her, and she shall give rise to nations; kings of peoples shall come from her." (NRSV)

Reflections

A covenant relationship is commenced. It starts with an elderly couple. They at first cannot believe the promise, because they are focused on limits and deficits, but God is the God of abundance, as the couple will soon learn.

This week Rev Billy Graham, world renowned evangelist died at the age of 99. Many will recall going to one of his crusades in Sydney in 1959, 69 and 79. The 1959 crusade was held at the Sydney showground, and changes the lives of many. One of the hymns that was popularised by these crusades was *How great thou art*.

1. O Lord my God, when I in awesome wonder, consider all the works thy hand has made, I see the stars, I hear the mighty thunder, thy power throughout the universes displayed:

> Then sings my soul, my Saviour God, to thee, How great thou art, how great thou art! Then sings my soul, my Saviour God, to thee, How great thou art, how great thou art!

2. When through the woods and forest glades I wander, and hear the birds sing sweetly in the trees; when I look down from lofty mountain grandeur, and hear the brook, and feel the gentle breeze; 3. But when I think that God,
his Son not sparing,
sent him to die – I scarce can take it in
that on the cross, our burden gladly bearing,
he bled and died to take away my sin:

4. When Christ shall come with shout of acclamation and take me home – what joy shall fill my heart! Then shall I bow in humble adoration, and thee proclaim: My God, how great thou art! (*TIS 155 Copyright. Licensed. CCLI*)
